### READ CAREFULLY, THIS IS A GENERAL RELEASE OF CLAIMS FOR INJURY

In consideration of use of the GLP, Inc. Skate Park and any related services of the facility, its servants, agents, officers, employees, volunteers, and all other persons or entities acting in any capacity on its behalf (hereinafter referred to as "GLP"), the Skater, or if the Skater is a minor, the Skater's parents(s), hereby agrees to release, indemnify and discharge GLP, on behalf of the Skater and if the Skater is a minor, the Skater's parents, as follows:

The undersigned acknowledges that participation in the activities permitted at the Skate Park Facility entails known and unknown risks which could result in severe physical or emotional injury, or damage to the Skater, to property or to third persons. The undersigned understands that such risks simply cannot be eliminated without jeopardizing the essential qualities of the activity. The undersigned expressly agrees and promises to accept and assume all of the risks existing in this activity. The undersigned acknowledges that participation in this activity is purely voluntary and the Skater elects to participate at his/her own risks.

The Skater agrees that the Skater will wear their own appropriate protective equipment when using the GLP Skateboard facility. "Appropriate protective equipment" will include, at a minimum, their own skateboard, a helmet, elbow and kneepads and proper shoes. The Skater agrees to obey all of the rules and requirements of the facilities. The Skater understands that the Skater will be prohibited from suing the facility if the Skater does not follow the rules.

The undersigned hereby expressly and forever release GLP from all claims, demands, injuries, damages, actions, or causes of actions, and from all acts of active or passive negligence on the part of GLP arising out of or connected with the use of the services and facilities of GLP Skateboard Park by the Skater or any family member.

The undersigned certifies that the undersigned has adequate insurance to cover any injury or damage the Skater may cause or suffer while participating or else the undersigned agrees to bear the costs of such injury or damage personally.

The undersigned further certifies that the Skater has no medical or physical conditions which would interfere with the Skater's safety in this activity or else the undersigned is willing to assume and bear the costs of all risks that may be created, directly or indirectly, by any such condition.

The undersigned further understands and agrees to report any and all injuries immediately to GLP.

# RAMP RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All Skaters must have a signed release form in order to enter the skate park.
- All Skaters must provide their own skating equipment. Campers are not allowed to share equipment.
- Safety equipment must be worn at all times. This includes a helmet, knee and elbow pads. Gloves, wrist braces and hip pads are encouraged but not required.
- The number of people allowed inside the facility at any one time will be limited.
- If there are people waiting to use the facility, a time limit will be established by Camp Staff.
- In the event of an emergency or injury, all skaters must clear off equipment until directed by GLP staff.
- No food or beverages allowed within the fenced area.
- Recklessness will not be tolerated.
- No destroying or defacing property.
- No loitering after facility is closed.
- Skaters must follow the direction of GLP staff at all times. The GLP staff decision is final.
- Any camper possessing an item which may cause bodily harm to a staff member or another camper will be reported to the State Police and will result in immediate termination.
- Horseplay, foul language, not listening to GLP staff or any inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated.
